1. Financial Report:

Enrico reports he is working on treatment verifications. Enrico reports Bauer has removed more acres. Enrico reports he has spoken with Lindsey – the new plant pathologist UCCE San Diego County. 3. <u>Liaison Report:</u>

Sandra Zwaal reports there was one positive adult ACP found in the Valley Center area but that's all so far...no quarantine yet but more samples are still **Special Reports**

being analyzed at an approved lab. Sandra reports the Ventura quarantine has expanded slightly. Sandra reports there are fruit flies (Oriental and Tau) being found everywhere now. Sandra reports CPDPC meeting is November 8, and they may have an update on ethyl formate use and mitigation for HLB adjustments. Sandra reports the end of March will be HLB conference in Riverside.

4. Agriculture Weights and Measures Department Reports

Jason reports they are trying to contact the 25+ tree properties in Valley Center 1 mile radius zone to inform about positive find and what it means. Jason reports there were 10 properties in Rancho Bernardo refusing access to allow inspection, so county is in process of getting warrants for access. Jason reports they may remove one of the mitigations needed to move citrus within quarantine zone soon.

Daniel reports nothing new and all is going well.
