checking on it. Enrico reports he is going to put together a form letter so growers can easily sign on to support the ant letter. Enrico reports Greg Simmons is working with the Hemet PCD to test a disruptive ant trail pheromone. Enrico reports he is working on verifications of treatments so the district can send reimbursements out. Enrico reports Citrus Day was a productive meeting and they talked about Yellow Vein and what to watch for, Mustang working well on ACP as well as fruit flies, and treating for anthracnose.

3. <u>Liaison Report:</u>

Sandra reports there have been 67 positive trees in San Diego on 35 sites. Sandra reports CRB is accepting applications for CRAFT project. Sandra reports the HLB conference will be March 26-29.

4. Agriculture Weights and Measures Department Reports

Jason reports on AB 2745 – civil penalties bill... if a grower with 25 or more trees in a quarantine zone decides not to treat, the county can declare it a public nuisance and the Ag commissioner can issue a \$500 to \$1000 per acre penalty. Jason reports they are looking at doing a permanent exhibit at Valley Center Library with HLB / ACP info in it.

Daniel reports he is working with Enrico on determining if granular Lorsban is ok to use. If it is available, county will have to create updated paperwork to approve... so that may take some time to create.

Alex reports CDFA finished the Valley Center quarantine delimitation and collected almost 1000 samples, had four expansions of quarantine with 16 positive trees on 15 original sites...all trees were removed.
